



#### Want to add a sky

1. First you need a folder of skies. To do this you need to photograph a lot of sky images. When you have a partly cloudy sky, shot images every way you can, do this often, and save them in a folder.
2. After you have worked over your image and find you have a bald sky, go get the magic wand tool, {set the tolerance to 30, click-anti-aliased, no click in-use all layers}, click in the bald sky while holding down on the shift key, if you didn't get all you need, move to the area where needed, and click again. Now that you have the sky isolated you need to make a duplicat image in layers. Now go to edit>clear, go to select>deselect.
3. Open your sky image in photoshop, make sure the size is the same or larger than your orignal image, also that the resolution is the same.
4. Go to the move tool, and move the orignal image on to the sky image, you now have a sky layer in the layer palette make the sky layer active, you can move the sky to where you want it.
5. Now that you have what you like, you can flatten the image, and save it, or save it as a photoshop image.
