



### How to make a puzzle

1. Open an Image in Photoshop.
2. Make the image about 5x 7 in. at 180 DPI.
3. Duplicate background layer, and name it Puzzle. Turn off Background layer.
4. Activate the puzzle layer.
5. Go to filter>texture>texturizer>load texture>my computer>"c" drive>program file>adobe>Photoshop 6>presets>textures>puzzle. Set scaling 200, set relief 10.
6. Pick the puzzle piece you would like to use. Set your feather to 0. Lasso the piece you want to use. Set the lasso feather to 3. Go to select>save selection. In save selection box , name it P-1.
7. Go to edit>copy, go to edit>past. You now have a new layer name layer 1,make layer 1 active.
8. Go to the move tool and move the puzzle piece out of the way.
9. Make the puzzle layer active, go to select>load selection. In image box, under channel, pick 'P 1'. Then press delete, then go to select>deselect. The area inside the removed piece should be clear.
10. Make the background layer active, make a new layer between background and puzzle.[layer 2] Turn off background layer.
11. Pick a color [gray] to fill empty space, use paint bucket tool to fill space.
12. Make the puzzle layer active, click on puzzle layer, go to layer style click, go to drop shadow, in layer style window, set angle [clock] to 10, go to distance slider, move slider a little bit, go to bevel and emboss click, go to technique>smooth, move depth slider to 90 click ok.
13. Make layer 1 active, drag the style layer, to layer 1, now you have the same affect on the puzzle piece.
14. Move the puzzle piece to where you want it.
15. Go to image>image size, make image like you want it.
16. You are done.
