



Let`s make it 4

1. Open your image, and crop as you like.
2. Make a white background,go to file>new. in the new palette make it the size that you want, resolution- 100+, mode- RGB, contents- white.
3. In layers, make 4 copys of your image. Make layer 1 active, change it`s size, by going to image image size, make it a little less than 1/4 the size of the white background and the same resolution , next get the move tool in the tool box, click on the image and drag it on to the white background.
4. Make layer 2 active, size it the same as layer 1, flip it by going to image>rotate canvas>flip horizontal, move image next to image 1 on the background.
5. Do the same to the other two images, only flip one vertical, the other flip vertical,then horizont now crop to the size you want.
